Entry Fees

First entry is \$20.00 per day; second entry of the same dog, same day is \$10.00, third entry of the same dog, same day is \$10.00. All fees include a \$3.00 AKC recording fee per class.

A refund of entry fees, less the AKC recording fee and the judge's fees, will be given for any bitch that comes into season, or any dog or handler that is injured or ill, **provided that a written notification is given to the Trial Secretary prior to the beginning of judging that day.** Bitches in season are not allowed on the show grounds.

All exhibitors will receive a running order sheet. If you would also like a catalog, please order (\$4.00) on the entry form. A limited number will be available at the trial site for \$5.00.

Dogs Eligible to Enter

These trials are open to all dogs over the age of 15 months that are registered with the American Kennel Club or are registerable breeds that have obtained ILP numbers from AKC, except bitches in season, aggressive dogs, blind, or deaf dogs, or dogs suffering from any deformity, injury or illness which affect the dog's physical or mental performance.

JUDGING

Judging starts at 2:00 p.m. on Friday, 8:30a.m. on Saturday, and 8:00am Sunday. Judge's briefing and course walk-through will take place prior to that time.

Friday will be run Standard in one ring and JWW in the other ring. Standard will run First and JWW to follow, small to tall.

We will be running two rings alternately as follows for Saturday and Sunday:

Excellent Standard	Novice JWW
Open Standard	Excellent JWW
Novice Standard	Open JWW

The FAST class will be run in the Standard ring once Standard classes are finished. It will run Excellent, Open and then Novice.

For all classes the running order will be: Friday, 4",8",12",16",20",24",26"; Saturday, 26",24",20",16",12",8",4"; Sunday, 4",8",12",16",20",24",26". Running order within divisions will be determined by random draw, except that multiple dogs handled by the same person will be separated whenever possible. Preferred classes will run at the end of each jump height, except when necessary to separate dogs.

There will be no Equipment familiarization for Novice exhibitors at this trial.

SITE INFORMATION

These agility trials will be held outdoors on grass, with ring size of 100' by 100' (standard) or 100' by 100' (JWW). Two rings will be used, one for standard classes/FAST classes and one for JWW, but will not be run at the same time. Water and Portable toilets are on site. There is some shade, but please be prepared to provide shelter for your dogs. And of course, we know that you will uphold the great reputation of agility exhibitors by cleaning up after your dogs!

Directions to Latah County Fairgrounds

From the south: From HWY 95 N, turn right at the 2nd traffic light in Moscow, onto Hwy 8 east. Proceed 1 mile to the first light (at the eastside Marketplace Mall) and turn left onto Blaine St. Go one block to the stop sign, turn right on White Ave. The fairgrounds entrance is the first road on the left.

From the north: Take Hwy 95 S into Moscow. 95 S will become a one way street through town (also called Jackson St.). At the south end of town, the road will make a turn to the east (left) and in 1/4 mile there will be a traffic light. Be in the far left lane and go straight through the light onto Hwy 8 east. Proceed 1 mile to the first light (eastside Marketplace Mall) and turn left onto Blaine St. Go one block to the stop sign, turn right on White Ave. The fairgrounds entrance is the first road on the left.

From the west: Take the first exit into Pullman from Hwy 195 S. At the first light in Pullman, turn right onto Grand Ave. At the second light, turn left onto the one way street, Paradise. Paradise will become Main. Continue east on Main/Wa 270 for about 7 miles. At the Idaho border, WA 270 becomes ID 8. Proceed to the 4th traffic light, turn right on Jackson (one way south). Continue south through the next traffic light, then the road will make a turn to the east (left) and in a 1/4 mile, there will be another traffic light. Be in the far left lane and go straight through the light onto Hwy 8 east. Proceed one mile to the first light (eastside Marketplace Mall) and turn left onto Blaine St. Go one block to the stop sign, turn right on White Ave. The fairgrounds entrance is the first road on the left.

Height Divisions

The following jump heights shall be used in all agility trial classes:

Regular classes

8 inches.....for dogs 11 inches and under at the withers.....4 inches
12 inches.....for dogs 14 inches and under at the withers.....8 inches
16 inches.....for dogs 18 inches and under at the withers.....12 inches
20 inches.....for dogs 22 inches and under at the withers.....16 inches
24 inches.....for dogs over 22 inches at the withers.....20 inches
26 inches.....Voluntary jump height class.

Preferred classes

Handlers may choose to run in a higher height division, but not in a division lower than their proper height division. In the Preferred classes, dogs may NOT run in a higher height division that is determined by their withers height.

Height Card Information (PLEASE READ CAREFULLY)

AKC now requires that all dogs have a height card or, if jumping less than 24"(regular) or 20"Preferred, they must be measured at the show by the judge of record. If an AKC representative or designated measuring official is present, all dogs without a height card must be measured, regardless of height. **If you have a permanent or temporary height card, please include a photocopy of the card with your entry; if you are measured for a card at another trial after entering, please send a copy of your documentation to the Trial Secretary.** If you do not have a height card your dog will need to be measured before your first run, and you may need to check in early. Measuring information will be provided with confirmations, once we know how many dogs will need to be measured.

Obstacles

Obstacles used will meet the specifications given in the AKC regulations.

AWARDS

Rosettes will be awarded to 1st through 4th place in each height division in each class and each Preferred class.

Green Rosette will be awarded to all dogs receiving a qualifying score. All exhibitors will receive a plush, squeaky dog toy (Value of \$1-\$3) for each dog entered. One toy, per dog, per weekend.

For each Standard Agility class & Preferred, JWW class & Preferred, FAST class, & Preferred, the dog earning the highest score will receive a certificate good for a \$10.00 discount on one entry any Palouse Hills Dog Fanciers AKC agility trial in 2008, 2009, or 2010. In the case of tied scores, the dog with the fastest yards per second running time wins.

****Each dog entered in the 2 day trial will receive a toy. They can be picked up thru out the weekend at the check in table.**

Important Information For Exhibitors—PLEASE READ

Conditional, unsigned, incomplete, illegible, telephone, faxes, e-mail or telegraph entries cannot be accepted. Entries not on the official AKC forms, or photocopies of AKC forms without the agreement and rules on the reverse side of the official AKC entry form are not acceptable. *Returned checks do not constitute a valid entry.*

Owners are responsible for errors on entry blanks, for entering the same dog twice, or for entering a dog in a class in which it is not eligible regardless of who makes such errors. Dogs wrongly entered in a class may not be transferred to another class after closing.

Entries sent by Express Mail services MUST have the delivery signature requirement waived; otherwise they may not be delivered on time. The secretary will not pick up deliveries being held for signature, and no entries will be considered as being received until they are delivered. *Please note the opening time of 9 a.m. on April 2, 2008; no entries will be accepted before that time and date.*

If the entry is met prior to the closing date, an alternate list will be kept, in the order of receipt of entries; the list will be used to fill any vacancies from the withdrawals. Alternates that do not get into the trial will have entry fees returned after the closing date. Alternates may request return of their entry fees at any time prior to closing, but will forfeit their position on the alternate list by doing so.

Entry fees will not be returned in the event of errors or cancellation of entries after the published closing date, or in the event a dog is absent (other than what is specified on page 2), disqualified, excused by the veterinarian or Judge, or barred from competition by the show committee. No entry fee will be refunded if the trial cannot open or be completed by reasons of riots, civil disturbances, fire, Act of God, public emergency, act of a public enemy, or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee.

Confirmation of entry and schedule of judging time will be sent to the address on official AKC entry form after the closing date; if not received at least seven days prior to the show, contact the Trial Secretary. **Acknowledgement of receipt of entries prior to closing will be provided if the exhibitor provides a valid e-mail address on the entry form or includes a stamped, self addressed postcard with entry. Please do not telephone the secretary to ask if your entry was received.**

Palouse Hills Dog Fanciers, Inc. assumes no responsibility for any loss, damage or injury sustained by exhibitors, handlers, or spectators, or any of their dogs or property, and further assumes no responsibility for injury to any child not under the control of his or her parents or guardians. It is expressly understood that exhibitors are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and/or children. Any exhibitor whose dogs and/or children create unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the Show Committee, be asked to leave the show site and no refund of fees paid will be made. Exhibitors should follow veterinarians' recommendation to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases, and have appropriate vaccinations.

All dogs must be on leash at all times except when in the ring or designated warm-up area.

The safety of dogs is of primary concern. By entering this trial, exhibitors acknowledge that they are familiar with the rules and regulations of this sport, and that their dogs are familiar with and able to perform all obstacles safely.

Move up Information

Dogs may be moved up to a higher class at the request of the handler, as a result of completing an agility title at an earlier event, provided that the request is made to the Trial Secretary, in writing (email acceptable), by Wednesday June 4th, 2008. If a dog finishes a title on Friday or Saturday, the handler may move up for the next day by filling out a move up form (available at the event) and turning it in to the Trial Secretary within one hour of the presentation of awards for the class you are moving out of.
